Bib Return location: Keep your Bib if you are racing in another NEMS race. If you keep your Bib, it is your responsibility to return your Bib to NEMS at your last race or return Bib to Lucy at registration after race. We have a limited number of BIBs, so if you are not sure you will race again, PLEASE return your bib to Lucy.

Missed Gate or Stopping in GS, SG and DH

If a competitor misses a gate, they must no longer continue through further gates and shall be designated "DNF" [ACR 614.2.2]. If a competitor comes to a complete stop for any reason, they must no longer continue through previous or further gates [ACR 614.2.3]. This interdiction is valid in all events with a fixed start interval (DH, SG, GS, Parallel bracketed rounds).
