**Discipline:** GS

**Date:** 01-14-2022 Friday

**Race Trail Name:** Eisenhower - U2505/11/19- Start 708m Finish 545m. Can be reached from the Catskill Flyer (6 pack) or D Lift (triple)

**Race Day Communications:** All race day communications including DSQ's will be via the **Whatsapp** application. [To join the group click on the following link.](#)

**Live Timing:** The goal is for the race to be on Live Timing

**Bibs:** Don't forget your bib if you own a bib, for those that need a loaner bib we'll have it at checkin/registration.

## Timing for the Day

- Registration in Events Dept/Competition Services: Opens 8am (see location and notes below)
- Registration Closes 8:45am
- Lifts for Jury to load for course setting: 8:00am
- Lifts Open for Athletes: 9am
- Warm up on Adjacent Hills - Not on race hill
- Course Open for Inspection: 9:15am - No fast skiing on race hill
- Inspection Window Closes 10:00am (this means you can't enter the top of the course)
- Inspection Closes 10:15am (this means you must exit the race course by this time)
- First run Start Time: 10:30am
- Second Run First Race Immediately following First Run of First Race
- Set for Second Race
- Second Race Inspection to begin 45 minutes after end of first race
- Second Race Start Time 1 hr 15 min after the end of first race
- Awards Outside by Race Foundation Competition Center following race (need approval that this is ok?)

**Start Lists:** The start list has been shared on Whatsapp. You can also find [race #1 at this link](#) if you have problems with whatsapp. First and second run will be the same running order. You can find [race #2 start list here](#). We have reversed the running order within age class for the second race. If it is a two run race, both runs will be the same running order.

**Competition Services Registration Location.** As you are facing the mountain from the parking lot. It is the door to the far left of the main lodge. There are Nastar banners and a cardboard silhouette of Mikaela Shiffrin.

**Check/Registration Notes:** We will have your loaner bibs, or a bib you may have purchased at registration/checkin as well as tickets if you do not have an Epic Pass. If you have an Epic Pass & an Mid-Atlantic Bib, you do not HAVE to come to registration. Please remember your bibs!!

**Race Foundation Competition Center for Awards announcement:** Building all the way to the left as you are looking down from the mountain, to the right of D Lift. We will be doing a bib draw for door prizes here as well.

**Notes:** The goal is to fit in four runs, however, this will depend on how fast we run and how the course holds up, we may make it a one run GS for the second race.

**Notes for Inspection & End of Race:** No fast skiing for inspection or after the race ends, no course shadowing.

**Lift Spin Times:** Kaatskill 6 pack Flyer: 6 minutes without lift lines, D (Double) Lift to Mid Station 11min (if running), note you still have to ski to top of course so plan your time accordingly. Suggest being on the lift when they open so you are prepared and can get a warm up run in addition to inspection (depending on where you run).

**Suggested Warm up Trails:** Kaatskill Flyer to top, Hells Gate to Broadway bottom, easier warm up run to find your edges is Belt Parkway or WhiteCloud to Huega.

**Getting to Race Trail:** Kaatskill Flyer to top. Trails to take- Hells Gate to 42nd st to Eisenhower/Bleeker St: Option 2: Cliff or White Cloud to Bleeker St.

**Carrying Coats:** The current goal is to have people go around the racecourse to carry coats so we don't have any risk of movement on the hill or potential interference. So be sure to check with start control before carrying coats down the pitch.

**FIS Helmets:** Remember a FIS helmet is required for GS. No helmet mounts on the helmet.

**Basic Reminders:** If a racer loses a ski more than two gates above finish (U629.4) they must exit the course. If a competitor comes to a complete stop (e.g. after a fall), they must no longer continue through previous or further gates. Penalty for continuing to race after a complete stop is disqualification. ALL knee braces and back protectors must be worn under the GS suit or race clothing. DQs will be posted on the electronic Whatsapp communication board.
