Special Info/ Instructions: In SL if the competitor has not correctly passed the imaginary line from turning pole to turning pole and does not follow the normal race line, then they have to climb back up and correctly pass AROUND the missed turning pole, unless they will interfere with or is passed by the next competitor, in which case they must stop away from the course and not finish.. [ACR 804.3, 904.3] If a competitor misses a gate, they must no longer continue through further gates and shall be designated "DNF" [ACR 614.2.2]
